

MESSAGE FROM THE FOUNDER

Dear Friends, Supporters, and Partners,

As NSNU completes its first year, I am filled with gratitude. What began as a heartfelt idea—to bring dignity, joy, and connection to our elders—has grown into a movement spanning three cities and touching hundreds of lives. In a country where aging often leads to isolation, NSNU set out to change the narrative. We listened to stories in old age homes, celebrated festivals together, and saw our interns discover the wisdom elders carry.

Launched on 15th August 2024—India's Independence Day and the year I turned 60—NSNU has since hosted 31 events, partnered with 9 old age homes, and engaged more than 1,000 seniors. We welcomed 2 bright interns and laid the foundation for our flagship initiative, the Elders Club, a space where seniors can gather, grow, and feel seen.

None of this would be possible without our volunteers, donors, and well-wishers. As we look ahead, our mission remains clear: to celebrate aging and create spaces of belonging.

In the past year, NSNU has reached over 975 elderly across four cities, creating meaningful change and lasting bonds.




Foundation Laid


Total Assets and Liabilities are equal, establishing a balanced financial base
